

# How to Identify Lone Workers



Gaining insight into who your lone workers are and the nature of their roles is key to effectively managing the risks they may encounter. Use this checklist as a tool to identify employees engaged in lone work:

- Those working in remote areas.
- Those travelling alone for work.
- Those working outside of normal work hours.
- Those working from home.
- Those who enter client's premises and homes.
- Those who work in different parts of a building or site. E.g. two cleaners working on different floors.
